

**LEMOYNE BOROUGH COUNCIL
PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE
JUNE 17, 2009**

1. Call to Order...The Parks and Recreation Committee meeting, of the Lemoyne Borough Council, was called to order on Wednesday, June 17, 2009, at 6:00 P.M., at the Lemoyne Municipal Building, 510 Herman Avenue, Lemoyne, PA with Jodie Ruediger presiding.

2. Roll Call...Present at roll call was Jodie Ruediger, Chairperson and Mrs. West.

Absent was Lori Hegedus committee member.

Also present were John Paden, Robert Ihlein, Roi Basptiste, and Rose Levenson.

3. West Shore Rec. Swimming Lessons:

Mrs. Ruediger stated at the West Recreation Board meeting was discussing the cost of mangers. The West Shore Recreation Board stated the profit was going to be \$850. The cost of the lifeguards would bring the profit down to \$440. Mr. Ihlein suggested the board would change the time of the program. Mrs. Ruediger will take the suggestion back to the Board.

4. Joint Pool Party:

Ms. Levenson suggested having a second pool party. Mr. Redding from the Wormleysburg Rec. Board will help out with the pool party. The date of the second party will be July 25, 2009. The committee was all in favor.

5. Pavilion Policy:

Mr. Ihlein working on a fee schedule for the rental of the park's pavilions and the Borough facilities. Mr. Ihlein will bring the fee schedule back to the Administrative committee and the Parks Committee.

6. Pool:

Mrs. Ruediger suggested the Borough would contact New Cumberland and Wormleysburg councils on the pool budget. New Cumberland and Wormleysburg Boroughs may be able to kick some money into the pool. Mrs. West suggested the committee look into the membership fees in the August meeting.

Mr. Ihlein suggested closing the pool on August 23, 2009 and staying open late.

7. Negley Concert:

Mrs. Ruediger stated the Essex House will be bringing a bus of their residents to the concert. Mrs. West made a motion to have the Borough Manager to sign the contract for the concert. Mrs. Ruediger seconds the motion. All were in favor.

8. Playground Covering:

Mr. Paden asked for permission to purchase 300 cu. Yds. Of playground covering. The cost of the playground covering is \$13.13 per cu. Yd. from Enivor Products. The playground covering is on the COG bid. Mrs. West made a motion to purchase 300 cu.yd. of playground covering from Enviro Products. Mrs. Ruediger seconds the motion. All were in favor.

9. Grill and Benches:

Mr. Paden asked for permission to purchase a grill for Negley Park upper pavilion. Mr. Paden would like to purchase three benches for Woodside Park. Mrs. West made a motion to purchase a grill and three benches. Mrs. Ruediger seconds the motion. All were in favor.

10. Solar Flag Light:

Mr. Paden would like to purchase two solar flag lights at a cost of \$95.99 per light. Mrs. West made a motion to purchase two lights. Mrs. Ruediger seconds the motion. All were in favor.

11. New Playground:

Mrs. West suggested looking into the land beside the Borough office for a new Borough Park. Mrs. West asked Mr. Paden to design of the new park and a cost of a pavilion.

12. Homtown Day:

Mrs. West suggested Hometown Day program be under the control of the Park and Recreation Committee.

13. Adjournment: 7:15 P.M. There being no further business Mrs. Ruediger declared the meeting adjourned.
