

**LEMOYNE BOROUGH COUNCIL
PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE
AUGUST 19, 2009**

1. Call to Order...The Parks and Recreation Committee meeting, of the Lemoyne Borough Council, was called to order on Wednesday, August 19, 2009, at 6:00 P.M., at the Lemoyne Municipal Building, 510 Herman Avenue, Lemoyne, PA with Jodie Ruediger presiding.

2. Roll Call...Present at roll call was Jodie Ruediger, Chairperson, Mrs. West and Lori Hedegus.

Also present were John Paden, Robert Ihlein, Cookie Grugan, Nancy Gleim, Tom Beene, Grace Zuna, and Roi Basptiste.

3. Naming of the Upper Pavilion:

Mrs. Grugan discussed the letter received from Mrs. Richey on naming of the upper pavilion. The committee recommends a historic plaque and a bench to be placed at Negley Park. The items may honor both Mr. Gasull and Mr. Negley. Mrs. Grugan will be working with the Gateway Historical Society and the West Shore Alumni Association for donations. Mrs. Ruediger made a motion for Mrs. Grugan to continue with the Historical plaque and bench. Mrs. West seconds the motion. All were in favor.

4. Facility Fees:

The committee discussed the park pavilions rental fees. The following fees were recommended by the committee: \$50 per resident, non-profit, business and \$100. Per individuals, non-profit, and business located outside of the Borough.

The committee discussed the community room fees. The following fees will be \$20 per hour, \$50. for half a day (4 hours), and \$100 for all day. These amounts are for residents, non-profits, and business within the Borough lines and \$40.Per hour, \$100. for half a day (4 hours), \$200. for all day non-residents, non-profits, and business located outside of the Borough lines. The removal of trash from the community room will be taken to the Borough owned dumpster.

The exceptions from the charges will be the Senior Citizens and American Can.

Mrs. Ruediger made a motion to approve the fees for the parks pavilions and community room. Mrs. West seconds the motion. All were in favor.

5. Copper Ridge Recreational Fund:

Mr. Paden will be back to the committee with recommendations for Flynn Park. The committee agree to pay for the grill for Negley Park and four benches for Woodside out of the Copper Ridge fund. The estimated total is \$900.

13. Adjournment: 7:55 P.M. There being no further business Mrs. Ruediger declared the meeting adjourned.
