Minutes
June 14 2010, 7:00 pm

1. Call to Order: The Park and Recreation Committee of the Lemoine Borough Council was called to order on Monday June 14, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. with Stacy Gromlich presiding.
2. Roll Call: Present at roll call was Stacy Gromlich, Chairperson, Committee members Dave Beasley, and Lori Hegedus Visitors: Roi Baptiste, Mike Dunn, Pat Beasley, Robert Ihlein, Borough Manager and John Paden were also present.
3. Public Comment: There was no public comment.
4. Update on Pool:
 - a. Mr. Ihlein reported on the number of walk-ins and money collected at the pool to date. Family memberships purchased has been 123, Adult memberships purchased has been 38, children memberships purchased has been 19, and senior memberships purchased has been 36. Memorial Day weekend walk-ins totaled 943. A grand total of \$4,953 was received via walk-in rates.
 - b. Mr. Ihlein reported the procedures were changed due to the logistics of the tent and chairs on the newly laid sod. The parties will now use the pavilion and tables.
 - c. Ms. Gromlich discussed the teen parties with the committee. Ms. Gromlich will speak to Rose Levenson, Junior Councilperson about her interest in planning a party.
 - d. Mr. Ihlein discussed the park budget with the committee.
5. Ms. Hegedus discussed the fees for the use of pavilions and community room for larger fundraising events. Mrs. Beasley recommended having two different fees. Mr. Ihlein will check with different Boroughs and Townships to see how they handle rental fees.
6. Mr. Beasley discussed the issue of unlocking the community room during non-business hours. Mr. Beasley checked with Wormleysburg and Camp Hill to see how they handle building access for events during non-business hours. Wormleysburg gives a key to tenants with a deposit. Camp Hill has a volunteer unlock and lock up their room. The discussion was tabled until next month.
7. Ms. Hegedus inquired as to the status of the riverfront park and as to why the park has not been opened. Mr. Paden will check on options for making corrections to the currently hazardous drainage pipe and making it safe for use of the park. Ms. Gromlich recommended Mr. Paden get quotes on benches for this park area.
8. Ms. Gromlich discussed the skateboard park. The new location being discussed is beside the Borough's office, but a decision on the fire company's future building location is needed

prior to further discussion of this land. Ms. Gromlich is working on business grants and fundraising for this park renovation.

Ms. Hegedus asked about the conditions of the parks. The committee will take a tour of the parks in the August committee meeting.
