

**LEMOYNE BOROUGH COUNCIL  
PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE  
JANUARY 21, 2009**

1. Call to Order...The Parks and Recreation Committee meeting, of the Lemoyne Borough Council, was called to order on Wednesday, January 21, 2009, at 6:00 P.M., at the Lemoyne Municipal Building, 510 Herman Avenue, Lemoyne, PA with Jodie Ruediger presiding.

2. Roll Call...Present at roll call was Jodie Ruediger, Chairperson; Lori Hegedus and Susan West, Committee Members.

Also present was John Paden, Tom Cookie Grugan, and Tom Beene.

3. Gravestones:

Mrs. Grugan would like to place small gravestones on the graves. Mrs. Grugan will be contacting the State Police on using their ground penetrating radar to locate the graves. The grant was denied through DCNR.

4. Multi-Use Park Fundraising:

Mr. Beene discusses the design of the multi-use park. The park will have no lights located by the park. The committee is requesting for permission from the park committee to continue with the fundraiser. Turner Motors will donate a car at their cost and \$1,000. Mrs. Rruediger requested Mr. Beene to put the fundraiser on paper for the committee. Mrs. West request, Mr. Beene to have a public meeting in February for a survey of the citizens. Mr. Beene asked the committee to apply for a grant through DCNR in 2009.

5. Brush at Negley:

The issue was table until early spring.

6. Memorial Park:

Mrs. Farr asked the committee if the fence was removed at the dig location. Mr. Paden stated the fence is up around the dig.

7. DCNR Funding Workshop:

DCNR will be providing a workshop on grant writing. Ms. Hegedus will attend the workshop on playground equipment grant writing.

8. Playground Equipment:

Mrs. West suggested the committee would look at the playgrounds for new equipment. Mrs. West requested to use money from the capitol reserves. Ms. Hegedus agree with Mrs. West on the use of capitol reserves.

9. Pool:

Mrs. West stated the pool was never run as a business. Mrs. Ruediger will meet with Hampden Township Recreation Board. Ms. Hegedus suggested the committee have a business plan in place before the new pool is started.

10. Pesticide Course:

Mr. Paden requested permission to attend a pesticide course. Ms. Hegedus made the motion for Mr. Paden to attend the course and Mrs. West second the motion. All were in favor.

11. Adjournment: 7:30 P.M. There being no further business Mrs. Ruediger declared the meeting adjourned.
