

**LEMOYNE BOROUGH COUNCIL
PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE
January 20, 2010**

1. Call to Order...The Parks and Recreation Committee meeting, of the Lemoyne Borough Council, was called to order on Wednesday, January 20, 2010, at 6:07 P.M., at the Lemoyne Municipal Building, 510 Herman Avenue, Lemoyne, PA with Stacy Gromlich presiding.

2. Roll Call...Present at roll call was Stacy Gromlich, David Beasley, and Lori Hedegus.

3. Pool Updates:

Ms. Hedegus made a motion to give permission to the West Shore Churches. Mr. Beasley seconds the motion. All were in favor.

7. Students:

Ms. Hedegus discussed the use of college interns for park programs. Ms. Hedegus suggested adding e-mail addresses to the pool applications.

8. Cub Cadet Mower:

Mr. Paden asked permission to get a price on a cub cadet mower and present the price at the March's council meeting. The committee was all in favor.
