

**LEMOYNE BOROUGH COUNCIL  
PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE**

**February 8, 2010,**

1. Call to Order...The Parks and Recreation Committee meeting, of the Lemoyne Borough Council, was called to order on Monday, February 8, 2010, at 7:00 P.M., at the Lemoyne Municipal Building, 510 Herman Avenue, Lemoyne, PA with Stacy Gromlich presiding.

2. Roll Call...Present at roll call were Stacy Gromlich, David Beasley, and Lori Hedegus.

Also present were John Paden, Robert Ihlein, Mike and Rebecca Dunn, Patty Beasley, and Roi Basptiste.

3. Pool Updates:

Mr.Ihlein and Mr. Paden discussed the pool construction. Mr. Ihlein and Mr. Paden feel the project is on schedule. The grand opening will be on May 29, 2010. Ms. Hedegus will be looking for volunteers for the grand opening of the pool for the season. The West Shore Y has not yet responded to the questions from Mr. Ihlein. The Committee and Borough staff will continue to work with the West Shore Y on developing a program to run the pool. The committee worked on the 2010 pool rates. See attachment for pool rates.

4. Request for Park:

Mr. Dunn asked if the Borough has a park to supply an area for a football field. The committee discussed the parks and found no park available for a field. A request was presented from the Cedar Cliff Teener for the use of Negley Park. The committee all agreed to take the request to the Council in March.

5. Playground Grant Update:

Mr. Paden stated the Borough received information from DCNR on the grant. The grant was turned down for 2010. Mr. Ihlein and Mr. Paden will meet with a representative from DCNR on February 11<sup>th</sup>. Ms. Hegedus suggested looking into some different areas to update equipment in the parks.

6. Park Equipment Purchase:

Mr. Paden presented the purchase of a 2010 Cub Cadet Mower Model Number EX3200. The tractor is on the state contract and purchase price will be \$15,500. The tractor is budgeted for 2010 and came in under budget. Ms. Gromlich made a motion to purchase the tractor. Mr. Beasley seconded the motion. All were in favor. This action will be taken to council for approval in March.

Mr. Paden recommended purchasing a Shredder Vacuum/Self-Propelled. The machine will be used in the parks and along the streets. The purchase price is \$600 and will be purchased with the savings from the mower. Ms. Gromlich made a motion to purchase the vacuum for \$600. Ms. Hegedus seconded the motion. Ms. Gromlich and Ms. Hegedus were in favor and Mr. Beasley voted no. This action will be taken to council for approval in March.

7. Concert at Negley Park:

Ms. Hegedus suggested a committee would form for the concert. It was recommended the committee be organized in a formal committee structure. Ms. Gromlich will be the liaison between the Council Committee and the event committee. A meeting is schedule for February.

8. Community Clean Up Day:

The date for the community clean up day will be April 24, 2010.

9. Tennis Rates:

The tennis court rates will remain at \$10. Per resident.

5. Adjournment: 9:20 P.M. There being no further business Ms. Gromlich declared the meeting adjourned.
