LEMOYNE BOROUGH COUNCIL PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE

March 8, 2010

1. Call to Order...The Parks and Recreation Committee meeting, of the Lemoyne Borough Council, was called to order on Monday, March 8, 2010, at 7:00 P.M., at the Lemoyne Municipal Building, 510 Herman Avenue, Lemoyne, PA with Stacy Gromlich presiding.
2. Roll Call...Present at roll call were Stacy Gromlich, David Beasley, and Lori Hedegus.
3. Also present were John Paden, Robert Ihlein, Lynda Stark, Patty Beasley, and Roi Basptiste.
4. Pool Updates:

Mr. Ihlein and Mr. Paden discussed the pool construction. Mr. Ihlein and Mr. Paden feel the project is on schedule. The crews are working on the pump room and the light poles. The grand opening will be on May 29, 2010. Ms. Hedegus will be looking for volunteers for the grand opening of the pool for the season.

- A. The West Shore YMCA has met with Mr. Ihlein and Mr. Paden. The West Shore YMCA asked to add \$1,000, for insurance, to their proposal. Mr. Ihlein discussed setting a cap on the contract amount for the year. Ms. Hedegus made a motion to have the Borough hire the desk staff for the pool and Ms. Gromlich seconded the motion. All were in favor. The pool will stay open through Labor Day. A discussion was held on the "5 Years and Under" rule that is currently in effect at the pool and that the West Shore YMCA suggested. Ms. Gromlich made a motion for Mr. Ihlein to take the contract with West Shore YMCA to council. Ms. Hedegus seconded the motion. All were in favor.
- B. There was no report on pool membership.
- C. Ms. Hedegus will be working on the details for grand opening day.
- D. Mrs. Schaffer, from Dippin Dairy on Market Street, spoke about potentially wanting to submit a proposal for a concession stand at the pool. Mr. Schaffer will meet with Mr. Paden. Mr. Beasley made a motion for Mr. Paden to meet with Mr. Schaffer. Ms. Gromlich seconded the motion. All were in favor.

5. Concert at Negley Park:

Ms. Gromlich discussed the notes from the Concert at Negley committee meeting. A meeting is scheduled for March 11, 2010.

6. Requests for Use of Borough Facilities:

Ms. Gromlich presented multiple requests from the West Shore Recreation Commission for use of the Borough Facilities. The following uses were considered:

- A. Request to hold youth tennis lessons at Negley park in the morning July 12, 13, 14, 15. The request was amended to include the use of 2 of the 3 courts available for use that week and was approved.
- B. Request to use Memorial Park pavilion and playground area every Monday through Friday morning beginning in later June through early August for the Summerblast program. Due to competing requests for the park use, this request was amended and approved for use at Negley Park.
- C. Request to hold youth tennis lessons on Saturday afternoons in July at Negley Park. This request was amended to permit the use of 2 courts if they are vacant and only 1 court if they are in use and was approved.
- D. Request to hold yoga lessons at Negley Park in July on Saturday mornings for adults and Wednesday mornings for children. This request was approved.
- E. Request for the pool to hold a "Pooches Pool Party" in September. This request was declined due to the new pool not needing drained at the end of the season and not permitting dogs in the pool.
- F. Request for the usage of the Borough building on Saturday mornings in June, July and August for Zumba and Pilates and on Wednesday evenings in June, July and August for Stress Management Yoga. This request was approved. Ms. Hedegus made one motion for consideration of all the above decisions. Ms. Gromlich seconded the motion. All were in favor.

7. Playground Grant Update:

Mr. Ihlein asked the committee for a suggestion towards the next grant opportunity. The committee decided to stay with Memorial Park. The project will be the Skateboard Park, playground equipment, bathrooms, and wood carpet.

- 8. Adjournment: 8:29 P.M. There being no further business Ms. Gromlich declared the meeting adjourned.
