

**LEMOYNE BOROUGH COUNCIL  
PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE  
APRIL 15, 2009**

1. Call to Order...The Parks and Recreation Committee meeting, of the Lemoyne Borough Council, was called to order on Wednesday, April 15, 2009, at 6:00 P.M., at the Lemoyne Municipal Building, 510 Herman Avenue, Lemoyne, PA with Jodie Ruediger presiding.

2. Roll Call...Present at roll call was Jodie Ruediger, Chairperson and Lori Hegedus committee member.

Mrs. West was absented.

Also present were John Paden, Robert Ihlein, Linda Stark Dr. Judson, Corporal Karns, and Robert Farver.

3. AED for the Pool:

Dr. Judson suggested the Borough purchased an AED for the swimming pool for the season. Mrs. Ruediger made a motion to purchase a AED for the swimming pool, Ms. Hegedus second the motion. All were in favor.

4. Tennis Court Locks:

Dr. Judson inquires about Negley Park tennis court being locked. Mr. Paden reply the tennis court was paid for by Borough of Lemoyne tax dollars. Mr. Paden informed the committee Memorial Park was paid for by a grant. The committee was in favor of keeping the tennis courts at Negley Park locked.

5. Police Patrols for Parks:

Mrs. Ruediger discussed with Corporal Karns on issues in Memorial Park. Corporal Karns advised the committee, that officers will be doing more bike patrols throughout the park. Ms. Hegedus asked Corporal Karns about the neighborhood watch. Corporal Karns informed the committee that Corporal Ambrose will be putting together a plan for the new program.

6. Pool:

Mr. Ihlein discussed the hiring of the pool staff. Mr. Ihlein informed the office has received two applications for the manage position. Mr. Ihlein was instructed to look into schools and the YMCA for possible staff.

Mr. Ihlein discussed the group rates for the swimming pool. The rates for the season will be \$3. Per youth or \$30. Per youth pass. The rates for the pool staff will be as follows: Group supplies certified lifeguards the cost will be \$25. Per hour. Borough supplies the lifeguards the cost will be a minimum of two lifeguards at \$25. Per hour per staff. Mr. Ihlein was advised to contact the groups on the new group rates. Mrs. Ruediger made the motion to implement the group rates, Ms. Hegedus second the motion. All were in favor.

Mr. Ihlein discussed the employee rate for swimming pool pass. The rate will be a 50 percent of the cost of the pass. The following personnel will be able to purchase a pass: Borough employees, West Shore Regional Police Department and the West Shore Bureau of Fire. Ms. Hegedus made a motion to implement the rates, second by Mrs. Ruediger. All were in favor.

Ms. Hegedus suggested to advertise the swimming pool in the local paper. Mr. Ihlein was instructed to advertise in the local paper. Ms. Hegedus made a motion for the advisement, Mrs. Ruediger seconds the motion. All were in favor.

Mr. Ihlein received prices on new pool cards from Formex at \$58. To print 1000 cards. Mrs. Ruediger made a motion to purchase the cards, Ms. Hegedus second the motion. All were in favor.

Mr. Ihlein informed the committee on the meeting with Wade Associates for the new pool construction. Mr. Ihlein will be informing council on the cost of the agreement from Wade Associates at \$41,000. Mr. Ihlein feels the bids opening will be the June 17<sup>th</sup> Parks meeting.

Mr. Paden informed the committee the locks at the swimming pool will be rekeyed. The committee agreed on rekeying the locks.

Mr. Farver advised the committee he will be handling the vending machines at the pool for the season.

7. DCNR Grant:

Mr. Paden informed the committee, that Mr. Ihlein and Mr. Paden is working on the grant for playground equipment, wood carpet, ada bathrooms, and Multi-use Park.

8. Tree Grant:

Mr. Paden informed the committee that Mr. Ihlein and Mr. Paden attended a meeting on the tree grant. Mr. Paden and Mr. Ihlein will be working on the tree grant.

9. Adjournment: 7:45 P.M. There being no further business Mrs. Ruediger declared the meeting adjourned.
