Parks and Recreation Committee
Minutes
May 10 2010, 7:00 pm

1. Call to Order: The Park and Recreation Committee of the Lemoine Borough Council was called to order on Monday May 10, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. with Stacy Gromlich presiding
2. Roll Call: Present at roll call was Stacy Gromlich, Chairperson, Committee members Dave Beasley, and Lori Hegedus Visitors: Roi Baptiste, Mike Dunn, Pat Beasley, Dr. John Judson, Robert Ihlein, Borough Manager and John Paden were also present.
3. Public Comment: There was no public comment at this time.
4. Update on Pool:
 - a. Progress of Construction:

Mr. Paden reported the construction is on schedule. The crew is installing the sod around the pool. The crew will be in on Thursday to plaster the floors and walls of the pool.
 - b. Group Pool Rates:

Private parties were discussed and Mr. Ihlein agreed to talk to the West Shore YMCA about how they handle parties at their pool. Mr. Paden will look into the Hampden Township and Mechanicsburg party rates. The Maintenance department has two pop up canopies which can be used during pool parties while the pool is open to the public and will set the rented area apart from the general public area.
 - c. Updates on Hiring Desk Staff:

Mr. Ihlein discussed a job description for the desk staff. Mr. Ihlein will have a background and child abuse check done on the applicants. Ms. Hegedus recommended having Mr. Ihlein proceed with hiring the desk staff. Ms. Gromlich seconded the recommendation and it passed unanimously.
 - d. Pool Grand Opening:

Mr. Ihlein reported that the ribbon cutting will be at 1:00 PM. Ms. Gromlich reported that soda was donated and the Harrisburg Stampede cheerleaders will be at the opening.
 - e. Solar Heating:

Ms. Hegedus requested solar heating options for the pool be explored and it was agreed to look into this and review it as an option for next year.
5. Concert at Negley:

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The committee is working on getting banners donated to post in multiple local communities to advertise for the concert. The committee approved the rental of the tent and equipment which was ordered by the Borough.

6. Wood carpet:

Mr. Paden asked to order 300 cubic yards of wood carpet. The cost is \$14.46 per cubic yard. The wood carpet is on the state contract for purchases. Ms. Hegedus made a motion to purchase 300 cubic yards of wood carpet at a cost of \$4,338. Ms. Gromlich seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

7. Tennis Courts at Negley:

A resident shared concerns about some cracks in the tennis courts and Mr. Paden is working to have them repaired.

8. Borough Manager's Task List:

Mr. Ihlein requested an update on the plans for a multi-use facility in the Borough. The previous plan for the fundraising and building of a multi-use facility thought to be placed in Memorial Park is no longer being planned. The group of supporters is looking at locations to build a possible playground and skate park. One location being reviewed is the park next to the Borough Building which must be reviewed with the fire company as they may build a new firehouse on that property.

10. New Business:

Mr. Beasley discussed the community room rentals and people responsible for unlocking the door. Mr. Beasley asked if someone other than the police can unlock the doors. The discussion was table until the next meeting.

Fundraisers in the parks were discussed and there are no guidelines for use of the parks for this purpose. The discussion was tabled and will be added to the agenda for the next meeting.
