

**LEMOYNE BOROUGH COUNCIL
PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE
FEBRUARY 18, 2009**

1. Call to Order...The Parks and Recreation Committee meeting, of the Lemoyne Borough Council, was called to order on Wednesday, February 18, 2009, at 6:00 P.M., at the Lemoyne Municipal Building, 510 Herman Avenue, Lemoyne, PA with Jodie Ruediger presiding.

2. Roll Call...Present at roll call was Jodie Ruediger, Chairperson; Lori Hegedus and Susan West, Committee Members.

Also present were John Paden, Roi Baptitste, and Allison Kirkpatrick who is a Jr. Council member from Wormleysburg.

3. Pool:

Mrs. Ruediger stated the West Shore Rec. will use the pool for a pool camp at a discounted rate. This rate is in lieu of the contribution to the West Shore Rec. Mrs. West will be contacting the lifeguards for the 2009 employment. Mrs. West will be placing notices in the local schools for hiring of lifeguards for the season. Mrs. West would like to see a phone number, e-mail address and a contact person name to be placed on the pool application. Mrs. West will be sending out letters to the daycares in the area for the use of the swimming pool. Ms. Hedegus, Mrs. West, and Mr. Paden will meet with Hampden Township Recreation Board on Thursday February 19, 2009. The meeting will work a business plan for the swimming pool.

Ms. Hedegus discussed the tennis court cards for the upcoming season. The new cards will be made in house with business cards.

4. Playground Equipment:

The committee discussed the purchase of playground equipment. Ms. Hedegus suggested taking a look at the strategic plan. Mr. Paden was instructed to recommend a piece of playground equipment to purchase for the 2009 season. Mr. Paden was instructed to work on a price for the bathrooms. Grants were discussed for the future purchase of playground equipment and the multi use facility.

5. Harrisburg Academy Property:

Ms. Hegedus has been meeting with Harrisburg Academy on a nature trail. The trail will start at the tennis court and continue through the woods to Riverview Road. The project may start in 2010.

6. Exercise Equipment:

Mrs. Ruediger was advised by Ms. McAllister on the signs for the exercise equipment donated by Blue Cross. A representative from Blue Cross will meet with the committee on the donation of the signs.

7. Joint Youth Pool Party:

Ms. Kirkpatrick is discussing a joint youth party with Wormleysburg and Lemoyne. Ms. Hegedus asked Ms. Kirkpatrick to work up a plan for the joint youth pool party.

8. HACC Theater:

Mrs. West stated that HACC has the flyers for the theater class ready to give out. The fee is \$45. per resident and \$55. for non-resident. Mrs. West stated Camp Hill will charge Lemoyne's residents the same price as a Camp Hill resident and Lemoyne will do the same for Camp Hill residents.

9. Eagle Project:

A Boy Scout contacted Mr. Paden on a suggestion for an Eagle Project. Mr. Paden recommended repainting the basketball court at Schell Park. The Borough will supply a park bench to be installed at the basketball court. The paint and other materials will be supplied by the Boy Scout.

10. Grill:

Mr. Paden suggested the Borough purchase a grill for Borough events. Mrs. Ruediger will talk with Mr. Ruediger on purchasing a grill thru his company. Mrs. West made a motion to purchase a grill, Ms. Hegedus second the motion. All were in favor.

11. Adjournment: 6:58 P.M. There being no further business Mrs. Ruediger declared the meeting adjourned.
