

LEMOYNE BOROUGH COUNCIL  
PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE  
SEPTEMBER 17, 2008

1. Call to Order...The Parks and Recreation Committee meeting, of the Lemoyne Borough Council, was called to order on Wednesday, September 17, 2008, at 6:15 P.M., at the Lemoyne Municipal Building, 510 Herman Avenue, Lemoyne, PA with Jodie Ruediger presiding.

2. Roll Call...Present at roll call was Jodie Ruediger, Chairperson; and Lori Hegedus and Susan West, Committee Members.

Also present Howard Dougherty, Don Edwards, Mary Ann Bedard and John Paden.

3. West Shore Recreation Commission Board...

Mrs. Ruediger said the West Shore Recreation Commission is having financial difficulties and there is a possibility the Board will be requesting an additional \$982 in 2008 to cover the operations. In addition the 2009 Commission budget is proposed to increase by five percent (or \$0.104 per capita) for a total of \$8,719.

On motion by Mrs. West, seconded by Miss Hegedus, not to approve the proposed 2009 budget increase and the proposed additional funding for 2008.

Motion carried with 3 aye and 0 nay votes.

4. Harrisburg Area Community College Theater Camp...

Mrs. West spoke the HACC and they provide all the equipment and personnel for the camps and manage the fees for the program.

On motion by Mrs. West, seconded by Miss Hegedus, to authorize the Harrisburg Area Community College place Lemoyne on the 2009 schedule.

Motion carried with 3 aye and 0 nay votes.

5. Swimming Pool...

Mrs. West recommended the hours remain the same for the 2009 season.

Miss Hegedus recommended evening and weekend memberships.

At the October 2008 Committee meeting the fees and hours will be discussed further.

6. Concert and Program Sharing...

Representatives from Wormleysburg and Camp Hill met with the Committee to discuss joint concert and program sharing. Each community outlined their park system and the amenities in each and the different events and locations of those events each year. A copy of the event inventory and park inventory is attached.

The next joint meeting will be at the November Committee meeting.

7. Adjournment: 7:22 P.M. There being no further business Mrs. Ruediger declared the meeting adjourned.
