Minutes
August 31, 2011, 7:00 pm

1. Call to Order: The Park and Recreation Committee of the Lemoine Borough Council was called to order on Wednesday August 31, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. with Stacy Gromlich presiding.
2. Roll Call: Present at roll call were Committee members Lori Hegedus and David Beasley. Visitors: Patty Beasley, Sharon Henley, Dr. John Judson, Todd Miller, Robert Ihlein, Borough Manager and John Paden were also present.
3. Public Comment: Mrs. Hernley mentioned concerns she still has about the pool. Specifically, swimwear is still a problem at the pool as well as consistency among lifeguards. Mr. Miller will be talking to the Manager of the City of Lancaster’s swimming pools. Mrs. Beasley stated three of her parents said how great the pool is this year. The Fire Chief of the West Shore Bureau of Fire stated the pool staff was very helpful during his pool party.
4. Pool:
 - A. Concerns of the Residents – There were concerns with actions of the lifeguards which was addressed with those guards.
 - B. Spanish Signage – Mr. Ihlein will look into having the rules translated and keeping a copy at the pool in alternate languages. Mr. Ihlein will be working on a booklet for next year.
 - C. Popsicles and snack sales – No report
5. Park Rules Ordinance Update – The Ordinance was returned to the committee for review after the solicitor made comments and a few alterations combining additional ordinances such as dog behavior in the park and tobacco use on borough property with the proposed ordinance draft. The committee was comfortable with the proposed changes.
6. Playground Equipment - Mr. Paden recommended purchasing a Game Time playground component unit for Schell Park. The budget has \$5,000 for a piece of equipment and the Copperidge account has \$8,500. Mr. Paden presented 2 options to the committee. Ms. Hegedus made a motion recommending the purchase of the option costing \$12,271.41 to council for approval. Mr. Beasley seconded the recommendation, which passed unanimously
7. Update on Volunteer Interest for Land near Harrisburg Academy – Ms. Hegedus plans to take this project on next year. Ms. Hegedus reported on September 30, 2011 is the Harrisburg Academy service day. Ms. Hegedus asked for any ideas for a project. The committee held a discussion and will get back to Ms. Hegedus in a week.

9. Old Business: Mr. Paden reported that the bronze statue being donated by the Verner Family will be placed at the end of September or early October at Negley Park. Mr. Paden reported that the materials arrived for the surface of the tennis courts at Negley Park. The borough maintenance crew will begin this work Wednesday or when the weather is clear.

10. New Business – Mr. Paden requested to attend a mini conference in Carlisle for Park and Recreation. Mr. Paden will attend a full day course on pool management and park maintenance. The cost of the conference will be \$132. The committee all agreed.
