

**LEMOYNE BOROUGH COUNCIL
PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE
MAY 20, 2009**

1. Call to Order...The Parks and Recreation Committee meeting, of the Lemoyne Borough Council, was called to order on Wednesday, May 20, 2009, at 6:00 P.M., at the Lemoyne Municipal Building, 510 Herman Avenue, Lemoyne, PA with Jodie Ruediger presiding.

2. Roll Call...Present at roll call was Jodie Ruediger, Chairperson, Mrs. West and Lori Hegedus committee member.

Also present were John Paden, Robert Ihlein, Dr. Judson, Roi Basptiste, Holly Easton and Todd Miller from WSRec. And Allison Kirkpatrick from Wormleysburg Rec. Board.

3. West Shore Rec. Swimming Lessons:

Mr. Miller discusses the cost of the services for the pool. Mrs. West asked Mr. Miller the cost of the lessons. Resident will be \$39. Per person and non-resident will be \$47 per person. The course will run for nine days and 45 minutes long. Dr. Judson asked the class size. Mr. Miller informed the lower level is a max of 8 and upper level is a max of 10. Mr. Miller informed the committee, he will take the cost back to the WSRec committee. Ms. Hegedus made a motion to lower the cost to \$20. Per hour for 2009. Mrs. West seconds the motion. All were in favor.

4. Joint Pool Party:

Ms. Kirkpatrick discusses the agenda for the joint pool party. The cost of the entrance to the pool for the party will be \$3.00 per person. Ms. Kirkpatrick is working on donations of food and drink. Ms. Kirkpatrick has two bands schedule for the pool party. The cost of the bands will be paid by the Borough of Wormleysburg. Mrs. West suggested Ms. Kirkpatrick to contact the Lemoyne Middle School's act teacher to have some posters made up for the party. Mrs. West made a motion to support the pool party. Ms. Hegedus seconds the motion. All were in favor.

5. Pavilion Policy:

Mr. Ihlein will be looking into a fee schedule for the rental of the park's pavilions. Mr. Ihlein will bring the fee schedule back to the Administrative committee and the Parks Committee.

6. Pool:

Mr. Ihlein discussed the hiring of the pool staff. Mr. Ihlein advised the committee of the hiring of pool staff has completed. Mr. Ihlein requested to hire a third assistant manager due to the increase of additional groups. Mrs. West made a motion to give Mr. Ihlein permission to hire a third assistant manager. Mrs. Ruediger seconds the motion. All were in favor.

7. Negley Concert:

Mrs. Ruediger requested a total of four toilets for the concert. Mr. Paden requested a meeting with the police department, fire police, and maintenance department.

8. Adjournment: 7:15 P.M. There being no further business Mrs. Ruediger declared the meeting adjourned.
