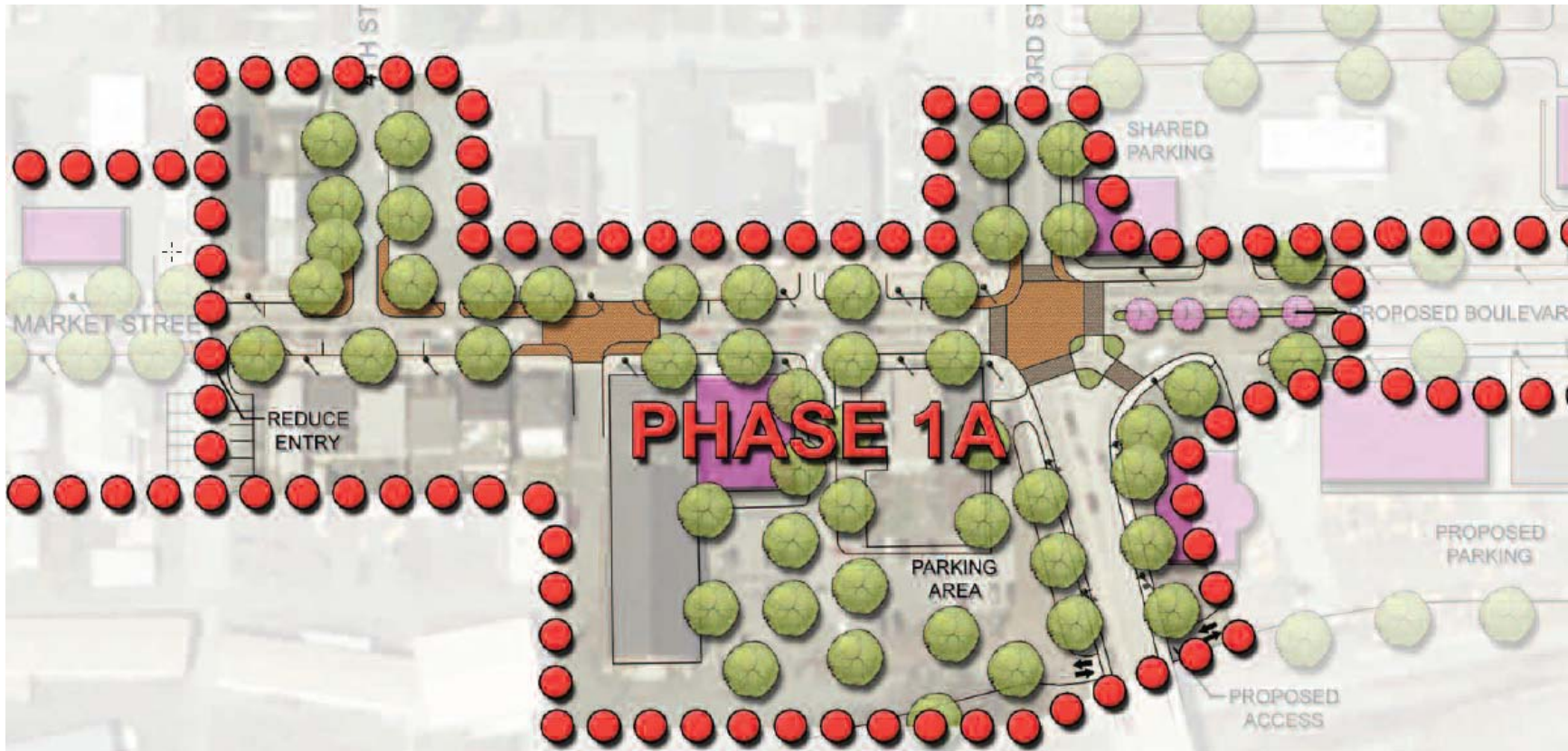




Downtown Revitalization --- Phase 1A



Phase 1A includes new concrete curbing, embossed colored concrete paving, new pavers in sidewalk areas, new light fixtures, ornamental street identification signs, interpretive panels/history, new street trees, shrubs and perennial plantings, freestanding planters, ornamental benches and trash receptacles.

In October 2007, CCHRA, on behalf of the Borough of Lemoyne submitted a grant application to the Dept of Community and Economic Development (DCED) for \$394,865. One year later, the grant was approved and the community met at Wray's Music for a Block Party on November 12, 2008.

In 2008 through DCED, State Senator Vance provided \$10,000 towards the purchase of benches and planters.

At the December 2008 meeting, Borough Council authorized the CCHRA to procure a contractor to complete the Streetscape Phase 1 Project. The Authority will hire a professional engineering firm to provide oversight of the work during the construction phase.
