PUBLIC SAFETY/EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT  
COMMITTEE MEETING  
SEPTEMBER 16, 2008

1. Call to Order...The Public Safety/Emergency Management Committee, of the Lemoyne Borough Council, was called to order on Tuesday, September 16, 2008, at 7:00 P.M., at the Lemoyne Community Building, 510 Herman Avenue, Lemoyne, PA with Dr. John Judson presiding.

2. Roll Call...Present at roll call was Dr. John Judson, Chairman; and Judy McAllister, Committee Member.

Jodie Ruediger, Committee Member, was absent.

Also present was Howard Dougherty and Ronald Frank.

3. Citizens and Visitors...There were no visitors present.

4. Tour of the 911 Communications Center...

The Committee members and staff went to the 911 Communications Center and received a tour of the 911 Center which takes emergency calls and dispatches police, fire and medical services.

5. Required NIMS Courses...

Dr. Judson said the three new council members are required to take the NIMS 100 and NIMS 200 courses for emergency management. Mr. Frank said he will get the web site for them to take the required courses.

6. Seventh Street Foot Bridge...

Mr. Dougherty said Norfolk Southern has received the bids and hopefully will award them quickly.

Dr. Judson asked if the bridge was being used by students or residents. Mr. Dougherty said the maintenance department boarded up the bridge and no one has removed the boards.

7. Replacement of the Lock Box at the Municipal Building...

Dr. Judson asked if the lock box had been replaced at the municipal building. Mr. Frank so not yet but he will get it completed.

7. Old Business...

A. Dr. Judson asked the status of the request of the state to take over the health inspections. The status will be checked and a report made to the committee.

B. Dr. Judson said Mrs. Ruediger said the fire extinguisher in the community room was out of inspection. Mr. Dougherty said all the fire extinguishers in the building were checked last week and recertified.

C. Basic Life Support and AED Training. Mr. Frank said he check with an instructor for Basic First Aid, CPR and AED training and it would be an eight hours class and the cost would be \$40 per person. Dr. Judson said he would like just an AED class so people will know what to do when there is a medical emergency and an AED is on the premises. Mr. Frank said he will check to see if we can just have an AED class.
