Lemoine Borough Council Budget Workshop Meeting Minutes—October 27, 2020

The Budget Workshop meeting of Lemoine Borough Council was called to order at 6:36 p.m. on Tuesday, October 27, 2020 via the Zoom platform. Present were Councilmembers Rebecca Coleman, Joe Gargiulo, Kasha Griva, Gene Koontz, Jesse Monoski, and Vice President Sue Yenchko; Council President Gale Gallo was absent. Also present were Mayor David G. Beasley, Borough Manager Cindy L. Foster, Executive Assistant Jenn Erickson, Assistant Treasurer Amanda Seibert, Code Enforcement Officer Trisha Rafferty, Maintenance Department Superintendent Cliff Karlsen, Assistant Maintenance Department Supervisor Brad Mills and Wastewater Treatment Plant Superintendent Bob Oakes.

Budget Review

Ms. Foster reviewed adjustments to the General, Fire, Stormwater, Sewer and General Fund Capital Reserve Funds that were made following discussions at previous budget workshop meetings. There were no changes proposed to the Pool, Sewer Capital Reserve, or Liquid Fuels Funds. No tax increase is proposed for 2021 nor is an increase in millage proposed for fire services. Transfers from the General Fund will accommodate any overages as needed in the Fire Services and Pool Funds.

Proposed fee schedule changes were reviewed. Staff will compile information from Camp Hill, New Cumberland and Wormleysburg on street cut and building permit fees prior to the November 5th meeting.

Being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:56 p.m. upon a motion by Mr. Monoski, second by Mr. Gargiulo.
