Minutes of the Meeting Held on September 14, 2016 at 6:00PM

1. Call to Order

A meeting of the Stormwater Committee of the Lemoyne Borough Council was held on Wednesday, September 14 2016 at the Lemoyne Borough Hall, 510 Herman Avenue, Lemoyne, PA. The meeting was called to order by committee chairperson Dennis McGee at 6:08PM.

4. Review of the minutes of the previous meeting

I. Illicit discharge detection and elimination

There was some discussion about the Lafferty Lumber fire and the foam that flowed into Ayers Pond. The Fire Department is not regulated by MS4 and this matter is not considered an illicit discharge.

Mr. Fair will need to check all major outfalls and report the findings by March 2017.

J. Tree planting

Mr. Fair reported there are no further plans at this time to plant more trees. The Borough is awaiting direction from the Shade Tree Commission.
