



## MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT

February 23, 2023, through March 29, 2023

### NOTE WORTHY ITEMS

- **Negley Park**
  - The park has been reopened and daily maintenance has begun.
  - Bench and table repairs are being completed.
  - A retaining wall was installed along the west side of the upper pavilion.
  - Facia covering was installed at the upper pavilion.
  - “Sand Diggers” are being repaired and repainted.
  - Bounce horses are being sanded and repainted.
  - Two adult swings have been added along the eastern walking path.
- **Schell Park**
  - Park maintenance is in full operation.
  - Bench repairs are being completed
- **Maple Street Park**
  - Park maintenance is in full operation
  - Bench and table repairs are being completed
- **Fort Couch**
  - Park maintenance is in full operation
- **Memorial Park**
  - Park maintenance is in full operation
  - Bench and table repairs are being completed.
  - CDBG grant for \$200K pertaining to the revitalization of the playground at Memorial Park was submitted to Cumberland County.
- **“Pool**
  - The pool has been weatherized and closed for the season.
  - Bench and table repairs are being completed.
  - The water level is being monitored and pumped out when required.
  - Exterior door molding is being replaced, due to them rotting away.
- **Highway**
  - The curb and sidewalk repairs along Warren and Clark Sts have begun.
  - Faded traffic signs were replaced at 3<sup>rd</sup> and Maple and 3<sup>rd</sup> and Lowther Sts. Intersections.
  - Street trees along Herman, Hummel, Walnut and Bosler are being trimmed.
- **Miscellaneous**
  - Green Light Go grant update was submitted to PennDOT.
  - Mini-Mural was installed at 510 Herman Ave.
  - Tennis court keys are available for the 2023 season at the office.
  - Replacement exterior door and metal main office door have been ordered.
