

## **Lemoyne Municipal Authority – Summary Report to Council**

### **March 14, 2023 Meeting**

#### General:

I reported that at the last Borough Council meeting two residents reported receiving very high cost estimates for connecting on-lot systems to the sewer system. During public comment one resident asked for more time for compliance and relief from the tapping fee. No written requests have yet been received.

#### Operators Report:

The red worm infestation is under control and the plant is running well and back in compliance. The problems in January did result in additional violations of discharge limits.

DEP has issued a formal Notice of Violation for the discharge exceedances over the past few months.

The higher nutrient discharges also will result in the plant exceeding the annual limits to the Chesapeake Bay. Credits will need to be purchased for this fiscal year.

#### Engineer activities for prior month:

The Chapter 94 report has been completed. Execution and submission were authorized.

Construction of the new UV system is underway with the base slab poured and wall forms in place.

#### Treasurers Report:

A motion was approved to award the 2022 Audit and DCED Annual Report to Trout CPA at a cost not to exceed \$8,900.

The first quarterly report for the County grant for the UV system is due April 10.

Bank balance end of prior month (rounded) - \$1,737,000.

Debt balance end of prior month (rounded) - \$12,865,000.

#### Solicitors Report:

Discussions continue regarding several real estate matters, with some progress noted.
